"We are excited to progress closer to construction and support employment and business



Construction is anticipated to begin in late 2023, a significant milestone for the Horsham Solar Farm.

Horsham Solar Farm is a 118.8 MWac solar project located approximately 5km east of Horsham and approximately 300km northwest of Melbourne in Victoria. The project sits within Victoria's Western Victoria Renewable Energy Zone (REZ), one of six across the State. Once operational, the solar farm will supply renewable electricity to the national

electricity market, generating power for approximately 55,700 Australian homes.

The Horsham Solar Farm would require the installation of solar panels and associated infrastructure including a short, underground 220kV, cable to connect into the grid at the existing Horsham Terminal Substation.

Horsham Solar Farm is supported by the Victorian Government through the Victorian Renewable Energy Target Auction (VRET2) and will contribute towards meeting Victoria's new renewable energy targets of 65% by 2030 and 95% by 2035.

Industry Briefings

Over 80 representatives from local businesses and service providers attended information briefings in Ballarat and Horsham in March 2023.

Those attending heard from project developers alongside representatives from ICN on the different work packages available, social procurement targets and how to submit an Expression of Interest via the ICN Gateway.

As a VRET2 project, there are social procurement targets to be met to ensure that the project offers opportunities to people who are based in the regions. The priority categories for VRET2 include women's equality and safety, Traditional Owners and Victorian Aboriginal People, and disadvantaged Victorians.





Leading Swedish renewable developer OX2 has acquired ESCO Pacific

OX2 sees great potential in the Australian market for renewables and opportunities to expand the operations of ESCO Pacific.

OX2 also plans to scale up operations through acquisitions in solar and energy storage and has the ambition to expand operations to onshore wind while exploring offshore wind and hydrogen.

Over the coming weeks, the ESCO Pacific name and logo will be replaced with OX2.


